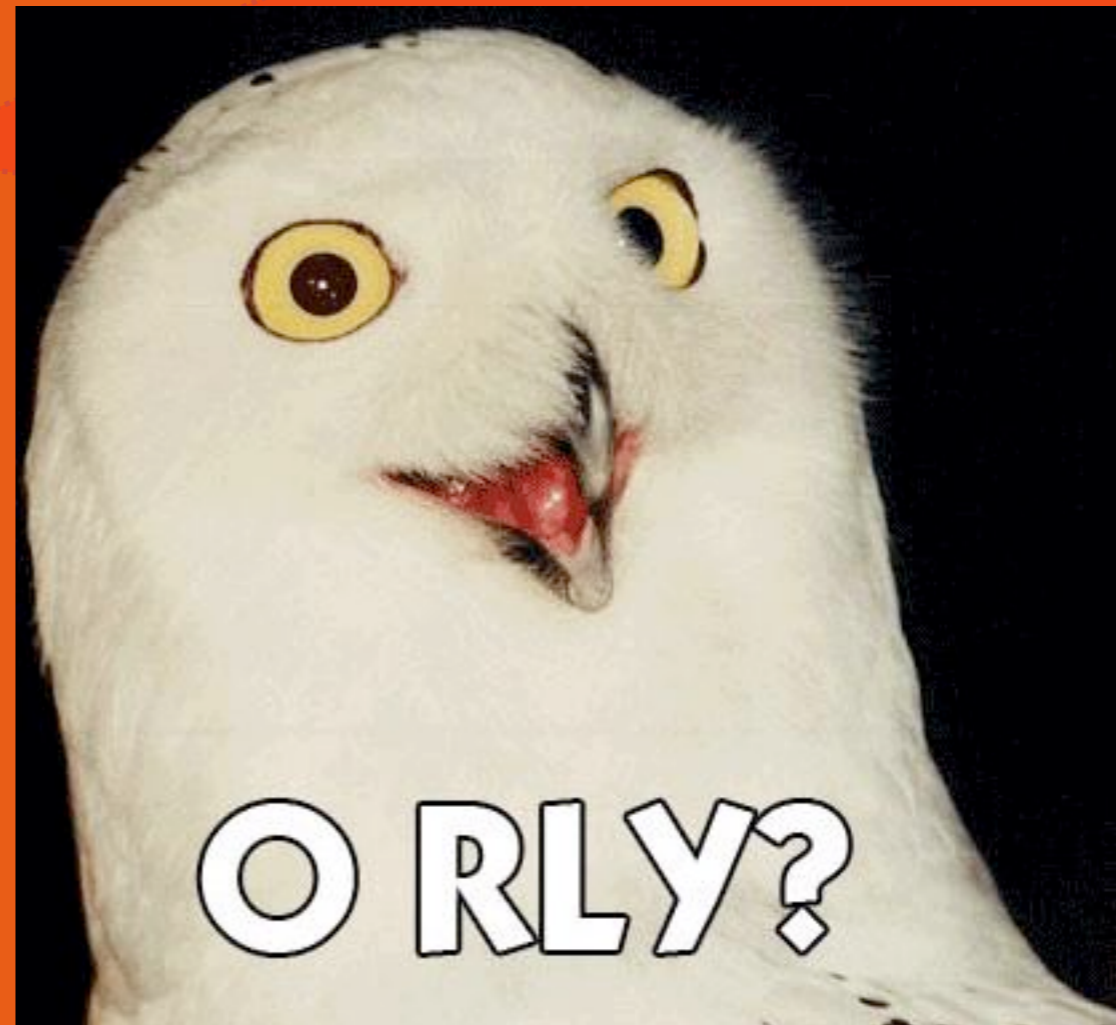

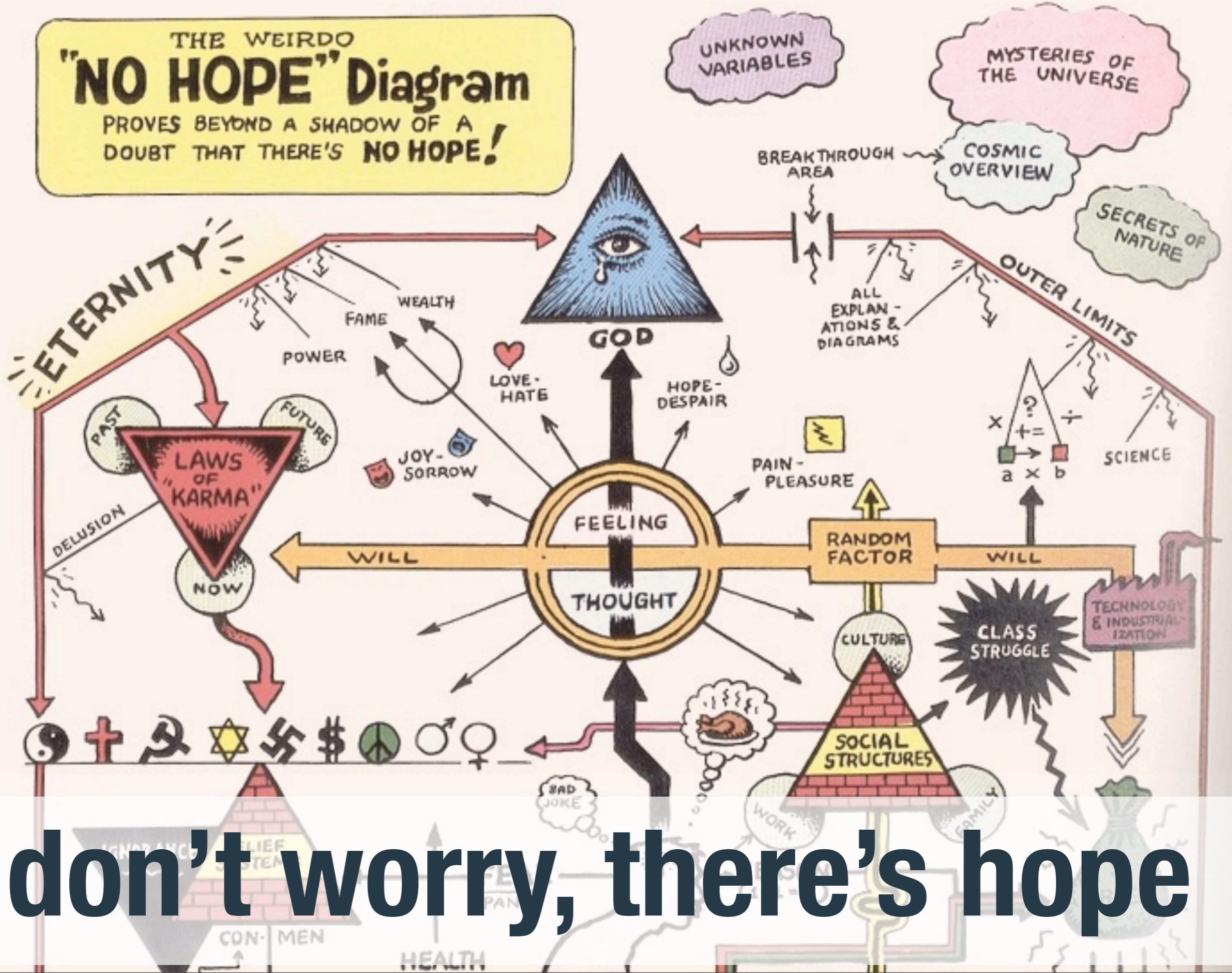

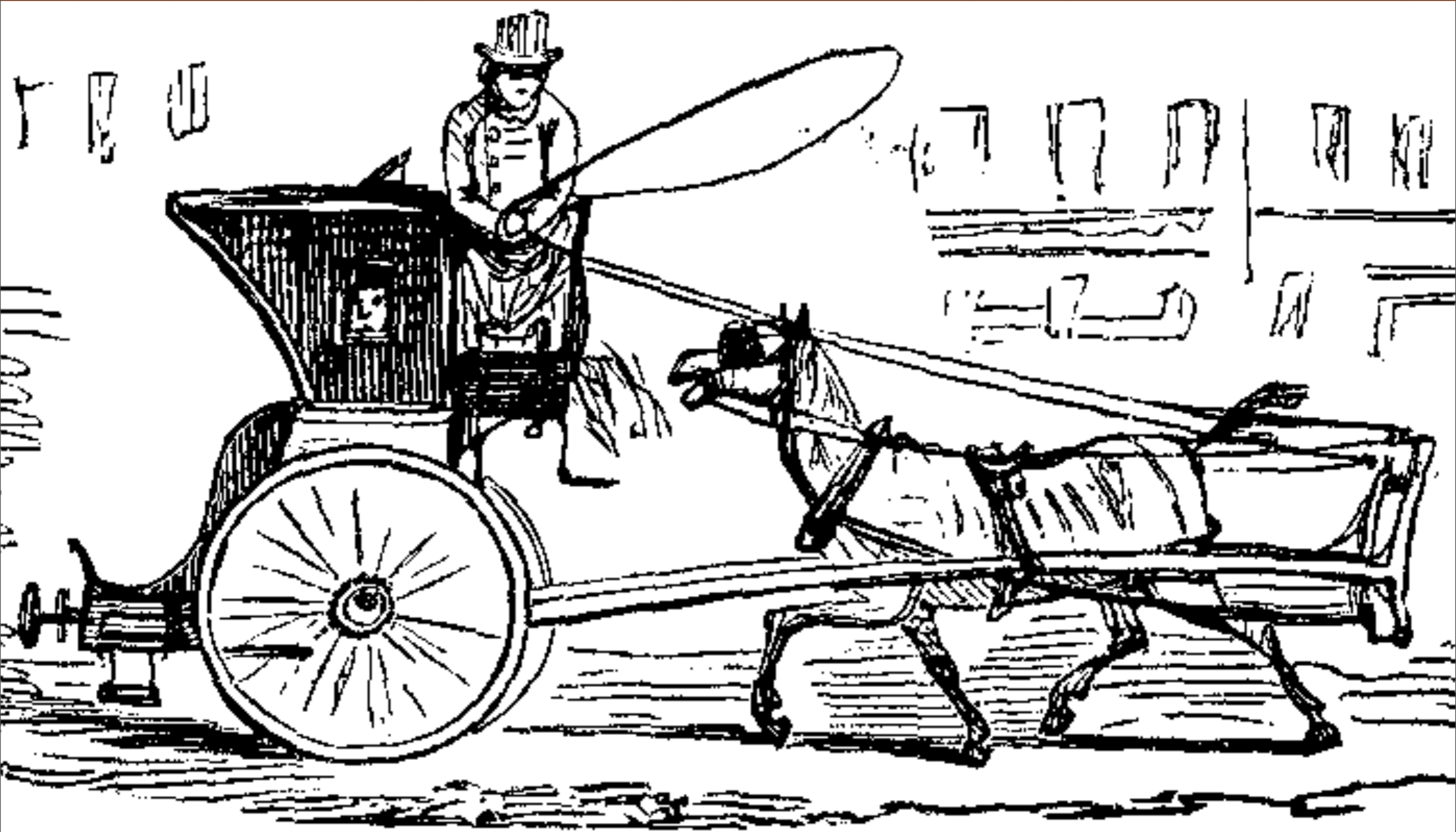

Knights In White Satin

[Pet Sounds](#) did not invent concept albums, and [Sgt. Pepper's](#) did not invent psychedelia, but by 1967, critics were fawning over [The Beach Boys'](#) record, and [The Beatles](#) were finishing theirs, inviting guests to the "A Day In The Life" session where they recorded their orchestral backdrop. The studios read the writing on the wall: concepts albums and psychedelia were the future. Deram Records commissioned [The Moody Blues](#), an in debt R&B band, to record a rock version of [Dvořák's Ninth](#) with the [London Phil](#). But left with the orchestra and no supervision, [The Moody Blues](#) ended up recording [Days of Future Passed](#), an original record perfectly integrating the orchestra not as a backdrop, rather integral members of the band. The record, with a cover reminiscent of classical albums, combines classical motifs, vocal harmonies, and lyrical complexity with rock and roll, pop, country.

FINE FRIENDLY FRIDAYS

The first Friday of each month will be noted on many Monroe County calendars from now on. That's the day set aside monthly by the Library Board of Trustees when patrons can return overdue materials to the library, no matter how long overdue, and have their fines excused for a dollar donation to the charity designated by the Board.

\$1.00 donation on that day cancels all overdue fines (not charges for lost items or library card replacement). Outstanding materials must be returned or paid for before fines can be forgiven.

Fine Friendly Fridays began on March 4, 2005 with every dollar donated going to the American Red Cross for tsunami relief efforts. There is a different charity selected each month through the end of the year. The goal is to have long overdue items returned to the library so they can be available to other patrons. Materials must be returned to be eligible, so items lost, ruined or un-returned for any reason will not qualify. All lost fines must be paid before overdue fines can be forgiven for the dollar donation. It's the perfect opportunity to return overdue materials and make a donation to a worthy cause at the same time.
